# Grand Beach Children's Golf 2016

Come participate in one of the great traditions of Grand Beach.

Children's Golf is open to all children of current Grand Beach Social Club Memberships entering 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade through sophomore year in high school.

The GBCG schedule includes a Score Day, Color Tournament and Flight Tournament and Junior Golf Dinner. The children are divided into three groups based on the grade level in the Fall of 2016. Each group plays a different number of holes and uses a different set of tee boxes.

**3 Holes** – play hole 4,5 and 6 from the Green Tees – Entering 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade in the Fall of 2016  
*Begin at 8:00 AM CDT*

**6 Holes** – play 1,2,3 and 7,8,9 from the Yellow Tees – entering 4<sup>th</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> Grade in the Fall of 2016  
*Begin at 8:00 AM CDT*

**9 Holes** – Play 1 through 9 from the Red Tees – Entering 7<sup>th</sup> Grade-Sophomore in High School in Fall of 2016  
*Begin at 10:30 AM CDT*

\*Younger golfers may be admitted if space permits and their handicap is within the normal range of the 3-Hole group. Teams will be assigned and posted shortly after Score Day.

## Requirements:

- All participants should have played golf before. If your child is new to the game, please consider contacting Don Butler in the Pro Shop for individual or group lessons. (269) 469 – 4888
- Golfers unavailable for the full season may elect to play only in the Color Tournament or the Flight Tournament; the cost is the same. **Please do not register your child for either tournament unless they will be able to play their matches on at least two of the three Thursdays involved in that tournament. While make-up matches are allowed if circumstances require, it is not fair to the other players to have too many make-up matches to schedule.**
- Parents of golfers must be members in good standing of the Grand Beach Social Club and commit to scoring at least two times during the season for each golfer they have participating in the program. Please establish your membership for the season prior to registering for Children's Golf.
- Golfers should turn in at least one, (preferably more)(as many as possible) set of practice scores at Grand Beach, on the same holes they will play for their group. These scores are due by June 23<sup>rd</sup>. Come to Score Day even if you have turned in scores – the more scores we have to work with – the more accurate your handicap will be.

- All flight matches must be completed by 5pm on the Wednesday before the next round.
- All Final Matches must be completed by 5 PM on Thursday, August 4th
- Golfers without a reasonable attempt to to reschedule will be asked to forfeit their match.



# GRAND BEACH LADIES' BRIDGE IS BACK

**2016 Really Brings Something for Everyone**

**Register for The Ladies' Tournament, Beginners Bridge Lessons, or Competitive Bidding Lessons now! Can't commit now? Join us on the spur of the moment for Social Bridge or by August 24<sup>th</sup> for Monkey Day!**



**Tournament Tuesday**, a long-standing tradition, continues. Grab a partner and sign up for the **Ladies Bridge Tournament** on Tuesday nights at 6PM CDT beginning on Tuesday, June 28 and ending on Tuesday, August 23. (Note: Play on August 23rd will begin at 4 PM instead of 6 PM as we end the evening with dinner and awards.) During the tournament we play 24 hands each evening, rotating tables every eight hands. Each partnership is assigned one week to bring treats for the group. Awards are given out based on each week's play as well as on cumulative totals for the year. Participation in the tournament is open to all female members of the Social Club with a basic knowledge of the game for a fee of \$25. If a member's bridge partner is not eligible to join the Social Club, they may participate in the tournament as a guest but will be required to pay a higher fee of \$40 to cover program costs subsidized by the Social Club. All fees are due in cash on the first night of the tournament. Can't come every week? Sign up as an alternate for no charge. Preregistration is required.

**Beginners Bridge** moves to Wednesdays this year. This six-week class goes over the very basics of bridge, so no prior knowledge of the game is necessary. Taught by Meg Piper, the class draws on both a text (Book 1 of Audrey Grant's Bridge Basics Series) and her memories of learning around her parents' card table. (This means that there are cheat sheets, lots of table talk, and a great deal of actual play to help you learn.) Classes will take place on Wednesday mornings from 9-11AM CDT beginning on July 5 and ending on August 10. Pre-registration is required. The fee for the class is \$30 and includes the cost of the text.

**Competitive Bidding** is a new class intended to follow-up on the basics taught in Beginners Bridge. In Competitive Bidding, we cover preemptive bids, overcalls, and takeout doubles, discussing how to make the best of your hand even if you aren't the natural opener. We will be using Book 2 of Audrey Grant's Bridge Basics Series as an outline for the class. You do not need to have taken Beginning Bridge to enroll, but you should have a basic knowledge of opening 1 bids. Lessons will take place on Wednesday afternoons from 1-3 PM CDT with the 6-week session beginning on July 5 and ending on August 10. Preregistration is required. The class fee is \$30.00 and includes the cost of the text.

**Social Bridge** is a great way to get some practice playing bridge and learn from each other as you do so. Join us on Wednesdays, July 5-August 10, from 11-1 PM CDT for social play in the Village Hall. Cards will be provided for dealing out random hands; there will also be pre-dealt hands you can use to practice what is being taught in the lessons or talked about in the Chicago Tribune bridge column. This is a great chance for the ladies who are taking lessons to stay after or come early and practice what they have been learning. It is also a wonderful opportunity for other bridge players in the village to just drop in and play a few hands while meeting some other interested players. There is no preregistration required or fee to be paid.

**Monkey Day** began last year as a fun evening of bridge where you play with a new partner every 4 hands, playing as many rounds of bridge as we can fit into the prescribed time limit. It was so much fun that we decided to do it again this year on Tuesday, August 30, starting time as yet to be determined. All female bridge players in the village are welcome; just let Meg know that you plan to come by Wednesday, August 24 so she knows how many players are in the rotation. Each participant brings a dish to share and \$2 for the pot. Look for reminders to sign up in the Breeze and at all Ladies Bridge events.
